# Goal Progress Report: Evals & Re-Evals

Users can still ☐ uncheck it, if the Goal Progress Report should not be included at the bottom of the eval/re-eval.

# Discontinued Goals

The report itself now includes the d/c date to show when a goal was ended, even if a goal is not mastered.

For example, a goal was set for the patient, and it was too lofty for that child's ability. The date for that goal being discontinued will now show on the Goal Progress Report.

# Example Goal Progress Report

The report will show all d/c and mastered goals and any current goal that does not have d/c or mastered date.
